Albert Jean Victorienne, III known to most as Vic, was the first born of three to Yolande and Albert Victorienne, Jr. in New Orleans, Louisiana September 27, 1956. Vic was a proud alumnus of St. Augustine High School playing the trumpet, flute, and clarinet in the Marching 100 band and member of the swim team. Vic graduated from Xavier University with a Bachelor of Science and then started at Tulane University for medical school before transferring to TSU in Houston where he received his doctorate in Pharmacology. While at Tulane, he met his good friend and future sister-in-law, Courtney Bethel. Vic worked as a Pharmacologist at the prominent cancer research center M. D. Andersen for several years. During this time Vic took a trip to visit his friend Courtney in Louisiana, while there he met Courtney's sister Allison Bethel. The two would go on to marry in 1996 and move to Cooper City, Florida, where they welcomed their beloved son Adam Jean Bethel Victorienne in 1997. Vic shared with his son a love for music, basketball, and the New Orleans Saints. Vic worked as a pharmacist, coached his son's basketball team, and enjoyed time with his family. Above all his accomplishments, Vic was most proud of his son. Vic moved back to New Orleans in 2016. Despite their distance, Vic maintained a close and loving relationship with his son which centered around their shared love of sports.

Vic died on March 9, 2022. Vic is survived by his son, Adam; his sister, Kathy; his niece and godchild Marci; nephew, Mark; grandnephew, Elijah and a host of other relatives and friends.
