The Honorable Angélique Aristell Reed passed away late Saturday night, November 16, 2019 after a brief illness.

She was the mother of Giaina Jazelle Warren. She was the daughter of Louadrian Dejoie and the late Dr. Langston F. Reed. She was sister to Langston D., Jennifer, Meredith and the late Randall Reed. She is also survived by a host of aunts, uncles and cousins, loving, devoted, and caring friends, staff and former staff members of First City Court, Section B.

Angélique was born in Washington D.C., May 23, 1960 and grew up in New Orleans, La. She was a graduate of Ursuline Academy, Xavier University and Loyola University School of Law.

Angélique was the senior judge of the First City Court for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana. She had been on the court since her election in 1998. Prior to her election to the Bench, she was an Assistant City Attorney and in private law practice in New Orleans.
