Anna E. Jollio, age 90, lifetime resident of New Orleans, LA passed away on Sunday, April 27, at Chateau de Notre Dame Hospice. Anna was born on April 2, 1924 to the late Laura Mitchell Payne and Henry Jollio.

Following her graduation from McDonogh 35 High School, she attended Straight Business School, worked for Majestic Life Insurance Company and graduated from Xavier University. She worked for the Social Security Administration and was the first black woman to be hired as a claims representative in the city of New Orleans. She was a speaker regarding Medicare until her retirement.

Anna was a lifetime member of Alpha Pi Chi Sorority. She was a member of the National Association of University Women for over 40 years as an officer and committee member. In 1999 she was Woman of the Year. She was a member of St. Andrew the Apostle Roman Catholic Church and a supporter of nine Catholic missions. She was also a member of Xavier University Alumni Association.

Anna was the youngest of six sisters and two brothers, all deceased. She is survived by six nieces and four nephews, Elva Clark and Carol Moran (New Orleans), Gina Lewis (Houston), Angela LaFargue Aldridge (Memphis), Jewel Johnson (Indianapolis), Orelia Young (Marrero), Stanley Brown (Prairieville, LA), Harold Brown (Indianapolis), Alfred Dorsey (Lle De Cite, France) and Alvin Nelson (Virginia), and a host of great nieces and nephews.
