Carrie Hazelwood Parker entered into eternal rest on Thursday, December 22, 2022 at the age of 96. She was born in Bogalusa, LA. Carrie was the eldest daughter of James Hazelwood of Kentwood LA., and Willie Mae Simmons Hazelwood of Bogalusa, La

Carrie spent most of her life as a resident of New Orleans where she met and married her late husband Alfred (Al) J. Parker, Sr. and to this union was born their only child Alfred (lil' Al) J. Parker, Jr.

Carrie was preceded in death by her parents James & Willie Mae Hazelwood, her husband Alfred (Al), two sisters, Virgie H. Nelson/Buckner and Joyce H. Issac.
