Clarence Scott Eugene, Jr. entered into eternal rest on Sunday, July 28, 2024, in New Orleans, LA at the age of 76. Beloved son of the late Clarence S. And Ruby W. Eugene, Clarence served a faithful and loving God through his Catholic upbringing, worshipping in several Parishes, including Holy Ghost Catholic Church and St. Mary of The Angels Catholic Church. He was a man who TRULY loved God. Clarence was a proud 1965 graduate of Walter L. Cohn High School and earned his bachelor's degree from Southern University of New Orleans in 1971.

Clarence retired as First Sergeant ("TOP") of the 337th Medical Company after a 30-year career that also included serving in the Vietnam War. Clarence retired from LSU Health Care Services Division, serving over 2 decades in the accounting department. He was a proud MAN and 40 year member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., holding several leadership positions including being named Treasurer Emeritus of the Sigma Lambda Chapter after decades of service.
