Earline Celestine Lockhart was born in St. Martin Parish in the town of Breaux Bridge, Louisiana to the late Aladin Celestine and Lucillia Alexander Celestine. She was born into the Catholic faith, and was baptized and received her sacrament at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church in Breaux Bridge.

At age 14, she left grammar school to live in New Orleans, La. to escape the chaos of her childhood. While living in New Orleans, she married the father of her children, the late Stephen J. Lockhart at Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church. Earline lived most of her adult life in New Orleans, but had to evacuate the city in 2005 back to Breaux Bridge, prior to Hurricane Katrina. After some time passed, she moved back to New Orleans.

Earline was a former employee during the 60's as a cashier at F. W. Woolworth's for eight years. She worked at Greyhound Bus Station as Assistant Manager in the café and gift shop, where she retired after twenty-three years. Earline also worked at Tisket-a-Tasket part-time until 2005. She had a good sense of humor and a love for family. She dedicated her life to raising her children.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Lucillia and Aladin Celestine;

sisters, Bessie Celestine Jones, Lula Mae Celestine Broussard, Ethel C. Daigle Sherfield and Anna C. Gordon; baby brother J. Earl Celestine; daughter Linda L. Nellum; grandson Wayne Lockhart.
