Edna Jane Breckenridge, affectionately known as "Gee," age 77, formerly of New Orleans, Louisiana, departed this world on Sunday, December 14, 2025. She was born on October 7, 1947, in Jasper, Texas, and later settled in New Orleans with her family at a young age. Edna was preceded in death by her parents, Master Sergeant Edmond Breckenridge and Stella Breckenridge.
