Eleanor Harrys Glapion, MSW LCSW age 89, was called home on Wednesday May 15, 2024 at home surrounded by her daughter, granddaughter, son-in-love and niece. Eleanor always had a God given talent, passion and calling for helping people. Social Work was the tool she used to accomplish this. She perfected her skills at the New Orleans Substance Abuse Clinic where she was a manager of youth services and shortly became the Clinic Manager. Eleanor became a Board Certified Social Worker in 1993. She served specific segments of the community at the Louisiana Department of Health, Metropolitan and Office of Addictive Disorders. She was the Region I Clinic Manager for New Orleans Center for Addictive Disorders. She was briefly an Adjunct at Southern University in New Orleans. She opened her private practice in two locations, Metairie Louisiana and Picayune Mississippi where she provided therapy to those who requested and needed help. She was most proud of the “giving an hour” program where she provided free therapy to veterans.

Eleanor was a member of St. Gabriel Church parish in Gentilly and for a time after Katrina, a member of St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church in Picayune Mississippi.
