



## Erroll Eldrige Audrict, Sr.

Erroll Eldridge Audrict, Sr. of New Orleans, LA passed away on February 7, 2023, at the age of 74. His life began on September 15, 1948. He was born and raised in the Uptown area of New Orleans, where he graduated from Booker T. Washington in 1967. He attended Southern University in Baton Rouge for one year until he was drafted in the U.S. Army on May 16, 1969. On February 15, 1969, he married his high school sweetheart, Carolyn Ball. While in the Army for two years, Erroll received three medals of honor and served in the Vietnam War. He was honorably discharged in 1971 and later deemed a Disabled Veteran. Erroll later worked as an Operating Engineer at the Sheraton Hotel and then Xavier University. After 18 years of working at Xavier, he decided to retire. He was a member of Greater St. Stephen Full Gospel Baptist Church. Erroll is survived by his wife of 53 years, Carolyn B. Audrict; one daughter, Sherrie Brown; one son, Erroll Audrict, Jr.; a daughter-in-law, Chedaphne Audrict; a son-in-law, Kevin Brown; four granddaughters, Jasmine LaCoste, Alanna Age, Chesney and Cheney Audrict; two great-grandsons, Jayce James and Blake Marton; two brothers, Larry and Rockie Audrict; two sisters-in-law, Wanda and Gail Audrict; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives, and dear friends. He is preceded in death by his parents, Audrey Johnson and James Audrict, Jr.; brothers, James, III, Lorrington, Sr., and Ricky Audrict.
