Henry Louis Dolliole, Jr., of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, affectionately called “Junior,” passed away unexpectedly on November 9, 2023 at the age of 89. Henry was born in New Orleans on October 23, 1934. He was the eldest of three children, including sister Jeanette and brother Lloyd, born to Florabell and Henry Dolliole Sr. His parents and brother Lloyd have predeceased him. Henry graduated from Joseph S. Clark High School and studied accounting at Delgado Community College. As a U.S. Air Force Technical Sergeant who specialized in Morse Code Translation, he was stationed in multiple undisclosed locations around the globe. Following his successful 20-year-plus military career, Henry was a beloved mail carrier for 20+ years.
