Otis Ray Jackson, Jr. was born on February 18, 1954 in New Orleans, Louisiana to the late Otis Ray Jackson, Sr. and Camille Jackson of Natchez, Mississippi. Washington High School. He was a dedicated long-term employee of Chisesi Brothers Meat Packing Company for 35 years where he served as Plant Manager.
