Rose Ethel WILSON “Sister” age 88, of Jesuit Bend, LA passed away peacefully on Friday, July 9, 2021. She was a member of the first graduating class of Scottville High School in 1957. After graduating high school, she became a licensed cosmetologist upon completion of the necessary requirements at Katies School of Beauty. A lifelong resident of Plaquemines Parish, she was a member of Saint Ignatius Catholic Church and then Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church. Following Katrina, she spent approximately ten (10) years in the Atlanta, GA area with her youngest daughter, Stacy Maria Langston, and three (3) years in Manning, SC with her recently deceased daughter, Chenille Marie Wilson before returning home to Belle Chasse, LA.

Rose was the eldest daughter of the late Charlie Wilson Sr and Agnes Hutchinson Wilson.
