Ryan L. Williams Jr entered eternal rest at University Medical Center on Saturday February 04, 2023, in New Orleans, Louisiana, at the age of 23. work and work ethic came from these outings with his dad. As a preteen he worked his first job at the Munch Factory, where he learned about teamwork, schedules, communication and how to cook. Ryan loved to cook and grill! Later he worked as a driver for his mentor Marc, a close family friend of his father, whom he considered as an uncle. In 2019 Ryan created RJ&J Transportation based off of the knowledge and skills he learned from his mentor.

Ryan had dreams of expanding his company, eventually owning his own home and getting involved with real estate. He became accomplished at running his company, managing other drivers, and always looking for opportunities of growth. He was a conscientious hard worker and dedicated to his family. He loved spending time with his daughter, his brothers, and cousins whenever time allowed. He was a caring, fun-loving, generous young man with a big smile, and an even bigger heart.

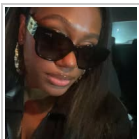
