Rychon “Rock” “Rocky” Davel Garrett, a New Orleans native, entered eternal rest on Saturday, June 21, 2025. Rychon D. Garrett received an unexpected call, and he accepted the call from the Lord at the age of 51. Although his family did not know this call was occurring, he accepted it.

Rychon was born on August 19, 1973, to the late Alice J. Garrett and Robert Garrett. Rychon was the second son born to Alice and Robert Garrett, out of three sons. Rychon loved the Lord, his family, his brothers, and having the ability to travel.

Rychon attended school in the New Orleans Parish School System and participated in the Boy Scouts. He attended Hartzell Methodist Center, Thomas Edison, George Washington Elementary, Mary D. Coghill Elementary, Andrew J. Bell Junior High School, F.W. Gregory Junior High School, Pierre Capdau Junior High School, and John F. Kennedy (JFK) High School (Class of 1991).
