Tiffany Marie Page-Pratt had a smile that would light up any room. Her bubbly personality, and kind, loving heart made her a joy to the family and friends who loved her dearly.

She was born September 19, 1984, to Zina Page and B. J. Bilbo in New Orleans, where she spent most of her life. Her maternal grandparents, Richard and Miriam Page, played a major role in her upbringing. She also was close to her paternal grandmother, Shirley Simms. Tiffany attended St. Simon Peter and Resurrection Elementary Schools. She was an active Daisy and Brownie with Girl Scouts of America. She attended Redeemer-Seton High School, where she was a two-year member of the Tall Flag Team and Captain in her senior year. She also attended Kennedy High School.

Tiffany enjoyed singing in school choirs and in the gospel choir at St. Maria Goretti Catholic Church, where she worshipped much of her life. She later joined The Bridge Southwest Community Christian Center in Houston and sang in the choir. She attended Delgado Community College and graduated from Blue Cliff College as a Nursing Assistant. As an adult, Tiffany worked mostly in the hospitality industry as a front desk clerk and then was promoted to front desk assistant general manager. She recently had begun working for U Haul and as an independent beauty consultant for Mary Kay, where in just three months she was about to be promoted to the position of “Red Jacket” (team leader).

In 2016, Tiffany married Dyanna Pratt, and they renewed their vows in an

elegant ceremony two years later. Tiffany was influential in the development of their beautiful 7-year-old daughter, with whom Tiffany shared a love of singing. Tiffany also enjoyed dancing, and performing (though few people actually saw her perform). She was a fashionista in the process of developing a modeling agency, Phat Divas, for curvy women.

Tiffany was living in Houston when she transitioned to her heavenly home on July 14th. She is survived by her wife, Dyanna Page-Pratt; her daughter, Kailee Pratt; her mother, Zina Page; her father, B. J. Bilbo; her paternal grandmother, Shirley Simms; four brothers, Frankie, Jeremy, B.J. Jr., Tarrell, and Bradley; three sisters, Kira, Keir Marie, and Savannah; her best friend since high school, Cambrian Jackson; her godchild, Thoas; honorary niece and nephew, Jazar and Azzon; godmother, Lisa Patterson; and a host of aunts, uncles, and cousins. She was preceded in death by her maternal grandparents, a special great aunt, Anita Thomas, and several other relatives. 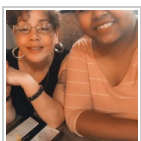
