TINA MARIE BYNUM GREEN gained her heavenly wings on Saturday, April 11, 2020 at Ochsner Baptist Hospital after suffering a heart attack and succumbing to the COVID-19 virus. She was 56 years old. Claiborne Avenue at Earhart and Lowes on Elysian Fields Avenue where she fostered a “more than customer” relationship with both staff.

Her love and passion for swimming kept her active in the Gert Town Family and in the Treme’ Community Center pool where she established friendships that became “like family” with many of the other participants. Many have said that “She is the Treme Center!” She was known for swimming many laps and could swim like a fish.
